## PRIVACY POLICY

---



### BACKGROUND:

Correlation Risk Partners understands that your privacy is important to you and that you care about how your personal data is used and shared online. We respect and value the privacy of everyone who visits this website, [www.correlation.eu](http://www.correlation.eu) ("Our Site") and will only collect and use personal data in ways that are described here, and in a manner that is consistent with Our obligations and your rights under the law.

Please read this Privacy Policy carefully and ensure that you understand it. [Your acceptance of Our Privacy Policy is deemed to occur upon your first use of Our Site. If you do not accept and agree with this Privacy Policy, you must stop using Our Site immediately.]

### 1. Definitions and Interpretation

In this Policy, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

<b>"Account"</b>	means an account required to access and/or use certain areas and features of Our Site;
<b>"Cookie"</b>	means a small text file placed on your computer or device by Our Site when you visit certain parts of Our Site and/or when you use certain features of Our Site. Details of the Cookies used by Our Site are set out in section 13, below;
<b>["Cookie Law"</b>	means the relevant parts of the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) Regulations 2003;]
<b>"personal data"</b>	means any and all data that relates to an identifiable person who can be directly or indirectly identified from that data. In this case, it means personal data that you give to Us via Our Site. This definition shall, where applicable, incorporate the definitions provided in the EU Regulation 2016/679 – the General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR"); and
<b>"We/Us/Our"</b>	means Correlation Risk Partners, a limited company registered in England under company number 5395760 , whose registered address is Emperor's Gate 114a, Cromwell Road, Kensington, London SW7 4AG.

## 2. **Information About Us**

- 2.1 Our Site is owned and operated by Correlation Risk Partners , a limited company registered in England under company number 5395760, whose registered address is Emperor’s Gate 114a,Cromwell Road, Kensington, London SW7 4AG.

## 3. **What Does This Policy Cover?**

This Privacy Policy applies only to your use of Our Site. Our Site may contain links to other websites. Please note that We have no control over how your data is collected, stored, or used by other websites and We advise you to check the privacy policies of any such websites before providing any data to them.

## 4. **Your Rights**

- 4.1 As a data subject, you have the following rights under the GDPR, which this Policy and Our use of personal data have been designed to uphold:
  - 4.1.1 The right to be informed about Our collection and use of personal data;
  - 4.1.2 The right of access to the personal data we hold about you (see section 8);
  - 4.1.3 The right to rectification if any personal data We hold about you is inaccurate or incomplete (please contact Us using the details in section 9);
  - 4.1.4 The right to be forgotten – i.e. the right to ask Us to delete any personal data We hold about you (We only hold your personal data for a limited time, as explained in section 6 but if you would like Us to delete it sooner, please contact Us using the details in section 9);
  - 4.1.5 The right to restrict (i.e. prevent) the processing of your personal data;
  - 4.1.6 The right to data portability (obtaining a copy of your personal data to re-use with another service or organisation);
  - 4.1.7 The right to object to Us using your personal data for particular purposes; and
  - 4.1.8 Rights with respect to automated decision making and profiling.
- 4.2 If you have any cause for complaint about Our use of your personal data, please contact Us using the details provided in section 9 and We will do Our

best to solve the problem for you. If We are unable to help, you also have the right to lodge a complaint with the UK's supervisory authority, the Information Commissioner's Office.

- 4.3 For further information about your rights, please contact the Information Commissioner's Office or your local Citizens Advice Bureau.

## 5. **What Data Do We Collect?**

- 5.1 Depending upon your use of Our Site, We may collect some or all of the following personal and non-personal data (please also see section 13 on Our use of Cookies and similar technologies): name, contact information such as email addresses and telephone numbers; IP address; web browser type and version; operating system; a list of URLs starting with a referring site, your activity on Our Site, and the site you exit to.
- 5.2 If you send Us an email, We may collect your name, your email address, and any other information which you choose to give Us.

## 6. **How Do We Use Your Data?**

- 6.1 If We do collect any personal data, it will be processed and stored securely, for no longer than is necessary in light of the reason(s) for which it was first collected. We will comply with Our obligations and safeguard your rights under the GDPR at all times. For more details on security see section 7, below.
- 6.2 If you contact Us and We obtain your personal details from your email, We may use them as follows:
  - 6.2.1 To reply to your email;
  - 6.2.2 To call you back.
- 6.3 You have the right to withdraw your consent to Us using your personal data at any time, and to request that We delete it.
- 6.4 We will not share any of your data with any third parties for any purposes.

## 7. **How and Where Do We Store Your Data?**

- 7.1 We only keep your personal data for as long as We need to in order to use it as described above in section 6, and/or for as long as We have your permission to keep it.
- 7.2 Your data will only be stored in the UK.
- 7.3 Data security is very important to Us, and to protect your data We have taken suitable measures to safeguard and secure any data We hold about you (even if it is only your email address).

8. **How Can You Access Your Data?**

You have the right to ask for a copy of any of your personal data held by Us (where such data is held). Under the GDPR, no fee is payable and We will provide any and all information in response to your request free of charge. 9. **Cookies and Analytics**

Our Site may place and access certain first party Cookies on your computer or device. First party Cookies are those placed directly by Us and are used only by Us. We use Cookies to facilitate and improve your experience of Our Site and to provide and improve Our products AND/OR services. By using Our Site you may also receive certain third party Cookies on your computer or device. Third party Cookies are those placed by websites, services, and/or parties other than Us. In addition, Our Site uses analytics services provided by Google Analytics, which also use Cookies. Website analytics refers to a set of tools used to collect and analyse usage statistics, enabling Us to better understand how people use Our Site.
